## Guidelines and Terms & conditions for Admission of Kashmiri Migrant candidates at IIIT Delhi.

The admission of Kashmiri Migrant candidates for Academic year 2019-20 which was kept on hold pending decision on a writ petition filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, will now be done through Joint Admission Counselling (JAC Delhi) in terms of the order dated 18.09.2019 of the Hon'ble High Court. During joint counselling, admission will be offered to candidates in accordance with IIIT-D merit list. Detailed instructions for joint counselling has been posted on the joint counselling portal (www.jacdelhi.nic.in). All concerned candidates who had registered for academic Year 2019-20 are, therefore, advised to visit the JAC Delhi website regularly, as well as the IIITD website, for further information and updates.

Further, all the candidates who may be finally admitted to IIITD are advised to note that they will be governed by the relevant ordinances and regulations of the Institute available at <a href="https://www.iiitd.ac.in/academics/resources">https://www.iiitd.ac.in/academics/resources</a>. The admission will be provisionally made subject to payment of relevant fees for 1st Semester 2019-20 and verification of documents as per procedures mentioned in the JAC Brochure and in the IIITD website. As the classes for 1st Semester have already started on 1st August,2019 and the Mid-semester examination which started from 13th September,2019 is also over, all such provisionally admitted candidates will fall under the category of semester leave being absent for more than 20 days. It would not be possible for them to cover up the missed quizzes and assignments at this stage and they would not be able to make up either the attendance or academic requirements. Hence, while they will remain on the rolls of the institute, they will actually start their classes from the 1st semester of the academic year2020-2021. However, they will not be required to pay the fees for the 2nd Semester 2019-20 (Winter Semester) as they will start the classes from 1st semester 2020-21; the fee paid for the 1st semester 2019-20 will be treated as the fee paid for the 1st semester 2020-21.
